Virtual School Updates

In September, we had some exciting news. We were one of three London boroughs to win a bid for the DfE's latest project—Post 16 Pupil Premium Plus Pilot Project. The project runs for 6 months and has a number of strands to it. We are working closely with Barnet and Southgate College on developing the PEP process at Post 16 and delivering training for their staff, as well as supporting them to carry out an art enrichment project with some of our unaccompanied asylum seeking young people. We are also working with the Post 16 team in Barnet to provide additional mentoring support to some of our most vulnerable Post 16 young people to support them to make steps back into employment, education or training. Cassandra Ofori and Jessica Clark will be commencing this work soon. Frazier Stroud is leading on this project so if you want to know more, do contact him.

Our work on supporting all children with a social worker in an advisory/strategic capacity, is developing and those of you with children on a child protection plan with Barnet will shortly be contacted by a third party company, Asset, to begin collecting attendance and achievement data. This company is similar to Welfare Call, but will work by extracting the information electronically rather than daily phone calls. You should have received a letter explaining the process.

We have had some other staffing changes. Maria Skoutaridou, PEP coordinator and Paul Whitcombe, Executive Headteacher, have left Barnet to pursue new challenges although Paul is remaining as a BPSI advisor. We wish them well and thank them for their contribution to supporting children in care. We are joined by a new case-worker, Sejal Patel. Many of you will know Sejal in a different capacity as she was Headteacher of Whiting Hill in Barnet. As always, thank you very much for all the support you give our looked after children and do contact us if you have any questions.

Pupil Premium Plus for Previously Looked After Children

Coming Soon....

Just before the Autumn Census we sent a reminder to Barnet schools to make sure you included certain children who were previously looked after on your census return. Pupil Premium funding for post looked after children does not come to the Virtual School but goes straight to the school. In order to access the pupil premium plus (PP+) monies which is £2345 per child in year groups reception to year 11, you need to make sure that this is reflected on your management information system for the Autumn census. You'll need to see a copy of legal paperwork which supports that the child is PLAC; that is **children** who have ceased to be looked after by a local authority in England and Wales because of adoption, a special guardianship order, or child arrangements order (previously known as a residence order).
